## Sustainable Design-Built



The military police facilities at Camp Lejeune represent a LEED campus project consisting of three separate buildings on site area of 301,840 square feet. The facilities are slated for completion in the fall of 2009 and represent a collaborative effort between Z Corp Design Build, Ivy Architectural innovations, and 2D Innovations. The project will be certified LEED Silver upon completion.

### Sustainable Features Include:

- Water use reduction of over 50%
- Diversion of 75% of construction debris from landfills to recycling centers
- Ozone-depleting free CFCs, HCFCs, and Halons HVAC equipment
- Permanent CO2 monitoring system with demand control ventilation
- High performance roofing system designed to eliminate a heat island
- Low-emitting adhesives, sealants, paints, carpet, and composite wood
- Site protection of 63,793 square feet from construction activities
